## THE NDIS HAS NOT YET REACHED ITS FULL POTENTIAL



The NDIS must define its fundamental purpose

Too many decisions are made without Participants at the centre

- Participants have not been sufficiently included in decision-making
- The Scheme's systems and processes to not put Participants' experience at the centre

Accessing the right support at the right time can be challenging

- Participants often feel let down by the officials who are supposed to help them navigate the NDIS
- There are not enough support options
- Participants are not provided with enough meaningful choice about supports
- The quality of supports is still an issue

The Scheme is too focused on transactions not transformations

- Providers are not rewarded for delivering on the Scheme's goals
- Scheme costs are overemphasised relative to benefits
